2 HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 2

3 IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA

4 SEVENTH LEGISLATURE - FIRST SESSION

5 Relating to the Constitutional
6 Convention.

7 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

8 WHEREAS at the general election held on November 3, 1970, the majority
9 of the votes cast were in the affirmative in answer to the question "Shall
10 there be a Constitutional Convention?"; and

11 WHEREAS the Lieutenant Governor is charged by the Constitution with
12 issuing the call and it is provided further in that document that the call
13 shall conform as nearly as possible to the Act calling the Alaska Constitu-
14 tional Convention of 1955; and

15 WHEREAS the 1955 Constitutional Convention was held at College, Alaska;
16 and

17 WHEREAS the meeting and housing facilities available to the delegates
18 would be second to none if the Convention were held at the new, modern and
19 greatly expanded University of Alaska Campus; and

20 WHEREAS not only is the University of Alaska Campus ideally located
21 geographically but it is easily accessible and would offer the delegates
22 a truly academic atmosphere in which to carry on their deliberations;

23 BE IT RESOLVED by the Alaska Legislature that by passage of this Reso-
24 lution the Legislature is indicating its intent and desire that when the
25 Lieutenant Governor issues the call for the Convention it be provided that
26 the delegates shall meet at the University of Alaska, College, Alaska in
27 facilities furnished by the University of Alaska Board of Regents.
