4 SEVENTH LEGISLATURE - FIRST SESSION

5 Relating to the construction of a  
6 road from Eagle to Circle.

7 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

8 WHEREAS, according to a recent federal study which projected road needs  
9 on a 20-year basis, a need was indicated for a road between Eagle and Circle  
10 in the near future; and

11 WHEREAS a road between Eagle and Circle would provide an alternate  
12 scenic route from Dawson Creek, Yukon Territory to Fairbanks; and

13 WHEREAS construction of this road would complete a needed vehicular  
14 transportation link between Tok, Eagle, Circle, and eventually Fort Yukon;  
15 and

16 WHEREAS the early completion of a road will be of great economic  
17 benefit to a great number of Alaskans and will otherwise serve the conveni-  
18 ence and necessity of the public;

19 BE IT RESOLVED by the Alaska Legislature that the Governor is respect-  
20 fully requested to direct the Department of Highways to immediately institute  
21 a study of the proposed road and formulate the necessary plans so that  
22 construction of the road between Eagle and Circle may commence at the  
23 earliest possible time.
