3 IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA

4 SEVENTH LEGISLATURE - FIRST SESSION

5 Relating to the construction of a road  
6 between Knik and McKenzie Point.

7 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

8 WHEREAS recent studies have indicated the need for additional port  
9 facilities on the North shore of Knik Arm, especially to facilitate the  
10 handling of boat cargos; and

11 WHEREAS to build a road between Knik and McKenzie Point would only  
12 entail approximately eighteen miles of construction and would open up a  
13 deep water port at McKenzie and a vast land resource and

14 WHEREAS, if additional port facilities were established at McKenzie  
15 Point, the Southcentral and interior areas of Alaska would realize a tre-  
16 mendous economic impact and the people would otherwise be benefited;

17 BE IT RESOLVED by the Seventh State Legislature that the Governor is  
18 respectfully requested to direct the Department of Highways to immediately  
19 undertake a feasibility study of a road between Knik and McKenzie Point in  
20 the Matanuska-Susitna Borough, Anchorage Highway District, and do all other  
21 things necessary to ensure early completion of this project.
