5 Relating to barracks facilities
6 at Camp Carroll.

7 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

8 WHEREAS the Camp Carroll facilities at Fort Richardson are utilized on
9 a continuing basis as a training site for the Alaska National Guard; and

10 WHEREAS among the facilities used by the Alaska Guard are some 70
11 barracks buildings for troop sleeping quarters; and

12 WHEREAS the present heating system in these barracks is totally anti-
13 quated and inadequate; and

14 WHEREAS the heating ducts now are located on the ceiling of the barracks
15 and because of that, at times, frost will form on the cement walls, making
16 sleep an extremely uncomfortable proposition; and

17 WHEREAS the federal government is currently in the midst of a six-year
18 general improvement program for Camp Carroll;

19 BE IT RESOLVED by the Alaska Legislature that the Department of
20 Military Affairs is directed to critically review the federal designs for
21 all future barracks construction with the purpose of taking the necessary
22 action to ensure the inclusion of improved and adequate heating facilities
23 in the barracks to be built at Camp Carroll.
