5 Relating to administrative leave for
6 state employees while attending certain
7 meetings which are of direct or in-
8 direct benefit to the state.

9 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

10 WHEREAS the policy of granting administrative leave for state employees
11 in attendance at meetings which are of direct or indirect benefit to the
12 state is not presently uniform and has resulted in some state employees
13 having to take annual leave in order to be in attendance; and

14 WHEREAS broad guidelines for individual supervisors would seem to be
15 the best method of approaching the problem; and

16 WHEREAS the guidelines should expressly provide for liberal interpreta-
17 tion since much direct and indirect benefit to the state is obtained by
18 the use of a broad administrative leave policy;

19 BE IT RESOLVED that the Alaska State Legislature respectfully requests
20 the Governor to direct the Department of Administration to develop broad,
21 liberal guidelines regarding administrative leave and to present these guide-
22 lines in the form of personnel rules to the Personnel Board for adoption.
