5 Relating to the Wasilla-Palmer

6 Junction highway to Anchorage.

7 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

8 WHEREAS the volume of traffic in the Anchorage-Palmer area of the state
9 is increasing each year at a greatly accelerated pace; and

10 WHEREAS the existing highway system is totally inadequate to handle the
11 needs of the residents of the entire area; and

12 WHEREAS the existing highway system causes much uncalled-for aggrava-
13 tion and inconvenience to a vast number of Alaska's people; and

14 WHEREAS this intolerable situation can only be rectified by speedy
15 completion of the new four-lane highway from the Wasilla-Palmer Junction
16 area to Anchorage;

17 BE IT RESOLVED by the Alaska Legislature that the Governor is respect-
18 fully requested to direct the Department of Highways to make completion of
19 the Wasilla-Palmer Junction to Anchorage highway the absolute highest
20 priority of the Department.
