7 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

8 WHEREAS the Alaska National Guard has served Alaska faithfully and  
9 well for many years; and

10 WHEREAS the Guard is recognized not only as a key element in the  
11 potential defense of Alaska but is also a vital force in combating the  
12 effects of natural disasters and accidents; and

13 WHEREAS in the course of required annual training, the Guard has also  
14 in the past undertaken extremely valuable public works projects in specific  
15 localities; and

16 WHEREAS outstanding examples of these projects can be found in the  
17 recreational bridge building activities and the construction of a much  
18 needed community target range in the Greater Juneau area; and

19 WHEREAS these projects are deeply appreciated by the people of the  
20 community and are of a type that would be appreciated by citizens of a  
21 great number of communities across the state;

22 BE IT RESOLVED that the Governor is respectfully requested to direct  
23 the Department of Military Affairs to hold annual active duty Guard encamp-  
24 ments near communities where the Guardsmen reside, beginning in 1972, and  
25 direct that in particular, those units with noncombat specialities annually  
26 undertake projects which enhance those specialities and serve local needs  
27 as well.
