5 Honoring Roderick M. MacKenzie.

6 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

7 WHEREAS word has been received of the recent passing of Dr. Roderick  
8 M. MacKenzie, in Victoria, British Columbia; and

9 WHEREAS Dr. MacKenzie, for a period of over 30 years made his home in  
10 Southeast Alaska, and traveled thousands of miles throughout Alaska aiding  
11 persons with dental problems at a time when professional dental services in  
12 Alaska were few and far between; and

13 WHEREAS he was dedicated to the economic and social well-being of all  
14 Alaskans and was especially active in numerous civic affairs in his chosen  
15 towns of Ketchikan and Petersburg; and

16 WHEREAS Dr. MacKenzie served his community and state ably as a member of  
17 the Territorial Senate from 1949 - 1951;

18 BE IT RESOLVED that the Alaska Legislature on behalf of all who knew  
19 him, expresses its most sincere sense of loss at the death of Dr. Roderick  
20 M. MacKenzie and extends its heartfelt condolences to his wife and family.
