5 Honoring Eugene H. Schaefer.

6 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

7 WHEREAS Eugene Schaefer recently met an untimely death; and

8 WHEREAS for many years Eugene Schaefer's devotion and love of music has  
9 been instrumental in providing Anchorage residents with the finest of musical  
10 entertainment as performed by the Anchorage Symphony Orchestra; and

11 WHEREAS over a period of sixteen years, he served as manager, librarian,  
12 board member, secretary of the board and in every other conceivable capacity  
13 with the Anchorage Symphony Orchestra; and

14 WHEREAS over the years Eugene Schaefer donated literally thousands of hours to  
15 the development of the symphonic music program in Anchorage, all without  
16 compensation to himself other than the knowledge that people were able to  
17 listen to and enjoy the symphonic music he loved so well; and

18 WHEREAS he also selflessly devoted other countless hours to his duties  
19 as a member of the Alaska Festival of Music Board and as a staff member of  
20 the Kings Lake Music Camp;

21 BE IT RESOLVED that the Alaska Legislature expresses its most sincere  
22 belief that Eugene Schaefer will be long remembered as a leader in the  
23 development of the Anchorage symphonic music programs and that his memory is  
24 cherished by all who have ever enjoyed concert music; and be it

25 FURTHER RESOLVED that the Alaska Legislature extends its sincere con-  
26 dolences to the family of Eugene H. Schaefer.
