6 snowmobile classic.

7 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

8 WHEREAS the "Midnight Sun 600" snowmobile race, which has been run  
9 between Anchorage and Fairbanks for the past few years, has become one  
10 of the most popular events in the state; and

11 WHEREAS this classic event is a true contest of man's will and determina-  
12 tion as well as a test of the highest magnitude for the machines involved; and

13 WHEREAS Alaskans from all corners of the state follow the progress of  
14 the racers and have voiced their enthusiastic support for this snowmobile  
15 classic; and

16 WHEREAS it has been alleged that this year's event is to be the last  
17 race which would be run over the public highway between Anchorage and  
18 Fairbanks; and

19 WHEREAS the inconvenience caused the motoring public is negligible and  
20 of short duration;

21 BE IT RESOLVED by the Alaska Legislature that the Governor is respect-  
22 fully requested to direct the Departments of Highways and Public Safety to  
23 permit the continuance each year of the "Midnight Sun 600", utilizing the  
24 Anchorage-Fairbanks Highway, upon request of the appropriate Midnight Sun  
25 officials.
