6 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

7 WHEREAS Anna E. "Betty" Park, long-time Alaskan and commercial artist  
8 personified, has recently passed away; and

9 WHEREAS Betty Park has left Alaskans with a rich legacy consisting of  
10 her many contributions to Alaskan arts and crafts which will remain forever;

12 WHEREAS she pioneered in her work with native clays and grasses in her  
13 pottery and glazes and her "Park" clay body and glaze recipes have been  
14 popularized throughout the state; and

15 WHEREAS versatility was another of her remarkable attributes, as she will  
16 also be long remembered for her imaginative set designs which have enhanced  
17 the performance of many a theatrical production for untold numbers of  
18 Alaskans;

19 BE IT RESOLVED by the Alaska Legislature that it most sincerely laments  
20 the untimely passing of Anna E. "Betty" Park, but also acknowledges the  
21 positive fact that her many contributions to the Alaskan arts will live with  
22 us forever.
