6 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

14 an indelible influence on her many students throughout the state and nation;

17 and dedication to the teaching profession the Alaska Legislature wishes to
18 make this date a memorable one for Florence Feldkirchner;
