5 Honoring A. H. Ziegler.

6 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

7 WHEREAS Alaska has lost through death one of its most widely known
8 and revered citizens, A. H. Ziegler; and

9 WHEREAS A. H. Ziegler was known and respected throughout the state as
10 a man dedicated to his chosen profession of the law, his community and the
11 state; and

12 WHEREAS he served with distinction in the Ninth, Tenth, and Twelfth
13 Territorial Legislatures in the House of Representatives and also served as
14 Mayor of Ketchikan with equal zeal; and

15 WHEREAS during his career he also was a member of the Board of Educa-
16 tion for over 25 years, during which time his expertise and dedication were
17 oriented toward the development of our Alaskan youth; and

18 WHEREAS he will be long-remembered as a man who gave of himself self-
19 lessly to better not only his home community of Ketchikan, but the welfare
20 of all Alaskans everywhere;

21 BE IT RESOLVED by the Alaska Legislature that it laments the passing
22 of A. H. Ziegler but acknowledges the gratitude of all Alaskans for the
23 shining heritage which was his, and which will remain as an example for
24 all Alaskans to strive for in the future.
