9 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

10 * Section 1. Sec. 1, Art. II of the Constitution of the State of Alaska
11 is amended to read:

12 SECTION 1. LEGISLATIVE POWER; MEMBERSHIP. The legislative
13 power of the State is vested in a legislature consisting of a
14 senate with a membership of twenty-one [TWENTY] and a house of repre-
15 sentatives with a membership of forty-one [FORTY].

16 * Sec. 2. The amendments proposed by this Resolution shall be placed
17 before the voters of the state at the next statewide election in conformity
18 with Art. XIII, Sec. 1, Constitution of the State of Alaska, and the election
19 laws of the state.
