5 Urging the broadcasting of marine  
6 weather forecasts to coastal  
7 communication centers.

8 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 WHEREAS the Alaska Communication System has been taken over by RCA  
10 Global Communications, Inc.; and

11 WHEREAS it is the understanding of the Alaska Legislature that distri-  
12 bution of marine weather forecasts to coastal communication centers has  
13 ceased since the transfer of the Alaska Communication System to RCA; and

14 WHEREAS knowledge of marine weather conditions is of the utmost  
15 importance not only to our numerous fishing fleets but to all other water-  
16 craft as well for the protection of property and human lives;

17 BE IT RESOLVED that the Environmental Science Services Administration  
18 is requested, as a much needed public service, to reinstate this important  
19 policy of broadcasting marine weather forecasts to coastal communication  
20 centers.
