2 HOUSE JOINT RESOLUTION NO. 14

3 IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA

4 SEVENTH LEGISLATURE - FIRST SESSION

5 Relating to the mail service at

6 St. George Island.

7 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

8 WHEREAS the people of St. George Island are forced to do without mail
9 service for months at a time other than an occasional air drop of first
10 class mail; and

11 WHEREAS this lack of any sort of regular mail service creates an in-
12 tolerable situation for all the persons living on St. George Island; and

13 WHEREAS the people of St. George Island have, with their own donated
14 labor, constructed an air strip which has the capacity to accommodate twin-
15 engine aircraft;

16 BE IT RESOLVED by the Alaska State Legislature that the United States
17 Post Office Department is respectfully requested to institute regular
18 shuttle mail service from St. Paul Island to St. George Island or from any
19 other point that may be appropriate.

20 COPIES of this Resolution shall be sent to the Honorable Richard M.
21 Nixon, President of the United States; the Honorable Winton E. Blount,
22 Postmaster General of the United States; and to the Honorable Ted Stevens
23 and the Honorable Mike Gravel, U. S. Senators, and to the Honorable Nick
24 Begich, U. S. Representative, members of the Alaska delegation in Congress.
