3 IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA

4 SEVENTH LEGISLATURE - FIRST SESSION

5 Relating to the dispatching of deeds
6 by the Bureau of Land management to
7 persons in Alaska.

8 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA;

9 WHEREAS many communities in the Kuskokwim-Yukon area have been incorpo-
10 rated into fourth class cities and have been surveyed by the Burea of Land
11 Management; and

12 WHEREAS residents of these communities were assured by the BLM at the
13 time of incorporation that they would receive individual deeds to their
14 property; and

15 WHEREAS some of these communities were incorporated and surveyed as
16 long ago as 1964; and

17 WHEREAS residents of these communities have not received deeds to their
18 property as of this date; and

19 WHEREAS this lack of individual deeds hinders progress in these com-
20 munities and prevents residents from obtaining small business loans without
21 great difficulty;

22 BE IT RESOLVED by the Seventh State Legislature that the Bureau of Land
23 Management is respectfully requested to immediately dispatch deeds to the
24 residents of the affected communities in the Kuskokwim-Yukon and other areas
25 in Alaska.
