HOUSE JOINT RESOLUTION NO. 38
IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA
SEVENTH LEGISLATURE - FIRST SESSION

Proposing that the Constitution of
the State of Alaska be amended to
require borough assemblymen repre-
senting a first class city, or other
class of city designated by law,
to be elected by city voters rather
than being appointed by and from
the city council.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

* Section 1. Sec. 4, art. X, Constitution of the State of Alaska is
amended to read:

SECTION 4. ASSEMBLY. The governing body of the organized borough
shall be the assembly, and its composition shall be established by law
or charter. Each city of the first class, and each city of any other
class designated by law, shall be represented on the assembly by one or
more assemblymen elected from and by the qualified voters of the city
[MEMBERS OF ITS COUNCIL]. The other members of the assembly shall be
elected from and by the qualified voters resident outside such cities.

* Sec. 2. The amendment proposed by this Resolution shall be placed
before the voters of the state at the next statewide election in conformity
with sec. 1, art. XIII of the Constitution of the State of Alaska and the
election laws of the state.
