5 Proposing an amendment to the Alaska
6 Constitution relating to dual office-
7 holding.

8 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. Art. II, Sec. 5, of the Constitution of the State of Alaska
10 is amended to read:

11 SECTION 5. DISQUALIFICATIONS. No legislator may hold any other
12 office or position of profit under the United States or the State or
13 a political subdivision of the State. During the term for which
14 elected and for one year thereafter, no legislator may be nominated,
15 elected, or appointed to any other office or position of profit which
16 has been created, or the salary or emoluments of which have been in-
17 creased, while he was a member. This section shall not prevent any
18 person from seeking or holding the office of governor, secretary of
19 state, or member of Congress. This section shall not apply to employ-
20 ment by or election to a constitutional convention.

21 * Sec. 2. The amendment proposed by this Resolution shall be placed
22 before the voters of the state at the next statewide election in conformity
23 with art. XIII, sec. 1, of the Constitution of the State of Alaska, and the
24 state election laws.
