2 HOUSE JOINT RESOLUTION NO. 71

3 IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA

4 SEVENTH LEGISLATURE - FIRST SESSION

5 Relating to the construction and  
6 operation of a hospital at Mountain  
7 Village, Alaska.

8 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 WHEREAS the people in the area of Mountain Village have no hospital and  
10 are required to fly to Bethel for medical care; and

11 WHEREAS bad weather often prohibits flights between these places; and

12 WHEREAS radio communication is very unreliable; and

13 WHEREAS this situation endangers the life and health of the people of  
14 Mountain Village, Yukon Delta and the whole coastal area within that terrain;

15 BE IT RESOLVED that the Alaska Native Health Service of the U. S.  
16 Public Health Service is requested to construct and operate a hospital at  
17 Mountain Village, Alaska.
