5 Amending the amendments section of the  
6 Alaska Constitution.

7 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

8 \* Section 1. Sec. 1, art. XIII of the Constitution of the State of Alaska  
9 is amended to read:

10 SECTION 1. AMENDMENTS. Amendments to this constitution may be  
11 proposed by a two-thirds vote of each house of the legislature or by  
12 initiative under Article XI of this constitution. The lieutenant  
13 governor shall prepare a ballot title and proposition summarizing each  
14 proposed amendment, and shall place them on the ballot for the next  
15 statewide election. If a majority of the votes cast on the proposition  
16 favor the amendment, it shall be adopted. Unless otherwise provided  
17 in the amendment, it becomes effective thirty days after the certifi-  
18 cation of the election returns by the lieutenant governor.

19 \* Sec. 2. The amendment proposed by this Resolution shall be placed  
20 before the voters of the state at the next statewide election in conformity  
21 with sec. 1, art. XIII of the Constitution of the State of Alaska, and the  
22 state election laws.
