2 HOUSE JOINT RESOLUTION NO. 112 *Am*

3 IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA

4 SEVENTH LEGISLATURE - SECOND SESSION

5 Relating to airline service between
6 Fairbanks and Juneau.

7 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

8 WHEREAS the newly decreed operating order of the Civil Aeronautics
9 Board affecting service in many areas of Alaska went into effect on Febru-
10 ary 7; and

11 WHEREAS it has been learned that the Civil Aeronautics Board has placed
12 a restriction on Alaska Airlines to the effect that no one may fly from
13 Juneau to Fairbanks or Fairbanks to Juneau on any Alaska flight that does
14 not make at least two intermediate stops; and

15 WHEREAS this restriction imposes an intolerable burden on Alaskans
16 wishing to travel between these two population centers of Alaska; and

17 WHEREAS the resulting inconvenience to the traveling public is doubly
18 aggravated because the other carrier with operating rights between Fairbanks
19 to Juneau only has three flights a week each way during a large portion of
20 the year; and

21 WHEREAS Juneau, being the state capital has a compelling need for
22 direct and frequent flights to all areas of Alaska;

23 BE IT RESOLVED by the Alaska Legislature that the Civil Aeronautics
24 Board is urgently requested to remove, at once, the restriction prohibiting
25 passengers from traveling between Juneau and Fairbanks on Alaska flights
26 that do not have two intermediate stops, or, at the very least, remove
27 that restriction for the days a person does not have the choice of traveling
28 via another carrier.

1 Nixon, President of the United States; the Honorable Secor D. Browne,
2 Chairman, Civil Aeronautics Board; and to the Honorable Ted Stevens and
3 the Honorable Mike Gravel, U.S. Senators, and the Honorable Nick Begich, U.S.
4 Representative, members of the Alaska delegation in Congress.
