5 Commending U. S. Army efforts in
6 the bush areas of Alaska.

7 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES:

8 WHEREAS it is universally recognized that emergency conditions in
9 Alaska's bush areas have been greatly alleviated by the continued vigilance,
10 perseverance, and self-sacrifice of the U. S. Army in Alaska; and

11 WHEREAS nothing typifies these efforts more than the provision of vital
12 medical services to needy outlying villages; and

13 WHEREAS illustrative of the recent medical effort is the design and
14 employment of a helicopter "medical pod", a virtually complete medical
15 facility in mobile form, designed and employed through the concerned efforts
16 of Major General James F. Hollingsworth;

17 BE IT RESOLVED that the House of Representatives sincerely commends the
18 general continuing efforts by the U. S. Army in Alaska to alleviate bush
19 medical conditions and particularly acknowledges and commends the efforts of
20 Major General James F. Hollingsworth in bringing the helicopter "medical
21 pod" into Alaskan operation.
