5 Commending the Naval Security Group  
6 Activity at Elmendorf Air Force Base.

7 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES:

8 WHEREAS, in response to a call for volunteers, seven petty officers  
9 assigned to the Naval Security Group Activity at Elmendorf Air Force Base,  
10 Alaska, painted one of the cottages at The Jesse Lee Home, an institution  
11 for emotionally disturbed children at nearby Anchorage; and

12 WHEREAS, as a result of the volunteer effort of the Navy personnel  
13 from Elmendorf, the cottage, consisting of eight bedrooms, a living room and  
14 dining room, was painted in less than six hours and readied for occupancy  
15 at a date earlier than anticipated; and

16 WHEREAS this selfless expression of civic spirit reflects credit not  
17 only on the Navy personnel who volunteered their time for this needed  
18 community project, but also speaks well for the concern of the United States  
19 Navy for the communities in which its men and women are stationed;

20 BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives of the Legislature of  
21 the State of Alaska that it commends the Naval Security Group Activity at  
22 Elmendorf AFB, Alaska, for its generous response to this request for volunteer  
23 help.
