5 Commending Grocers' Wholesale of
6 Anchorage.

7 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES:

8 WHEREAS Grocers' Wholesale, Alaska's largest distributor of wholesale
9 food products, has declared a 60-day moratorium on price increases on all
10 groceries, meat and fresh produce; and

11 WHEREAS, this wholesaler not only is Anchorage's major supplier, but
12 also ships vast quantities of food products to the rural areas of the
13 49th State; and

14 WHEREAS despite the fact that Phase II of the national administration's
15 economic controls does not affect rising prices in the food industry and
16 that costs have increased rapidly in this industry in the last several
17 months; and

18 WHEREAS the action of Grocers' Wholesale reflects the kind of individual
19 voluntary cooperation requested by President Nixon in an effort to keep the
20 inflationary spiral under control;

21 BE IT RESOLVED that the House of Representatives takes special pride in
22 commending Grocers' Wholesale, and its President, William D. Gibson, for
23 practicing enlightened self-interest, thus performing the greatest possible
24 public service through commercial self-denial by holding the line on price
25 increases on food products in its Alaska wholesale market for the 60-day
26 period ending May 31.
