4 SEVENTH LEGISLATURE - SECOND SESSION

5 Relating to hearings on proposed  
6 regulations of the Board of Welding  
7 Examiners.

8 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES:

9 WHEREAS the commissioner of commerce has given notice that the Board  
10 of Welding Examiners is proposing that new regulations be adopted under  
11 AS 08.99; and

12 WHEREAS many Alaskans will be affected by the adoption or rejection of  
13 the proposed regulations; and

14 WHEREAS the board has seen fit to hold only one public hearing, that  
15 to be in Anchorage on May 4; and

16 WHEREAS many Fairbanks residents desire the opportunity to also appear  
17 before the board to make oral statements and arguments relative to the  
18 proposed action; and

19 WHEREAS it would seem only proper and just that hearings on the pro-  
20 posed regulations be held in more than one place in the state and that  
21 Fairbanks, as the state's second largest population center, would be a  
22 logical place to hold a hearing on the proposals;

23 BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives that the Board of Welding  
24 Examiners is respectfully requested to hold a hearing on the proposed new  
25 regulations to be adopted under AS 08.99 in Fairbanks, Alaska on May 5 which  
26 is the day after the scheduled Anchorage hearing.

28 the Board of Welding Examiners and all other members of the board.
