5 Relating to the Southeastern Alaska  
6 High School Music Festival.

7 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES:

8 WHEREAS Juneau was recently the host city for the Southeastern Alaska  
9 High School Music Festival, participated in by several hundred students; and

10 WHEREAS the opportunity to participate in such an event is a social  
11 learning situation and gives the students the opportunity to perform and learn  
12 under nationally known musicians; and

13 WHEREAS the adjudicators for the recent Southeastern Alaska festival  
14 possessed an unusual amount of expertise and knowledge which they were able  
15 to share with the students; and

16 WHEREAS the presence of the three adjudicators was the one essential  
17 ingredient which made the Southeastern Alaska High School Music Festival a  
18 resounding success;

19 BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives that it conveys its  
20 thanks to the adjudicators for their time and sharing of their individual  
21 and collective knowledge which afforded the participants the maximum return  
22 on their stay in Juneau.
