3 IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA

4 SEVENTH LEGISLATURE - SECOND SESSION

5 Urging that the University of
6 Alaska's history of low resident
7 tuition be continued.

8 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES;

9 WHEREAS the University of Alaska has operated since its inception in
10 1917 on a virtual resident-free tuition basis; and

11 WHEREAS the University and students have been put to the test during
12 these many long and lean years; and

13 WHEREAS the wisdom of this policy has made itself only too clear with
14 the accomplishments of resident students; and

15 WHEREAS solid funding of the University is now possible for the first
16 time in its long history due to the recently discovered mineral wealth of
17 the state;

18 BE IT RESOLVED by the Alaska Legislature that the University of Alaska
19 is urged not to depart from the course of wisdom which they have pursued
20 for over half a century in providing virtually tuition-free higher education
21 to Alaskan residents.
