5 A BILL

6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the introduction of bills."

7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

8 * Section 1. AS 24.30.060(b) is amended to read:

9 (b) Bills introduced by the legislative council shall be delivered
10 with a letter of explanation to the rules committee of either house
11 and bear the inscription "Rules Committee by Request of the Legislative
12 Council"; bills introduced by the legislative audit committee shall be
13 delivered with a letter of explanation to the rules committee of either
14 house and bear the inscription "Rules Committee by Request of the
15 Legislative Audit Committee." Bills presented by the governor shall
16 be delivered with a letter to the rules committee of either house and
17 bear the inscription "Rules Committee by Request of the Governor."
18 Bills so presented and inscribed shall be received as bills carrying
19 the approval of the governor as to policy and budget impact. The
20 governor [OR EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR OF THE LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL] may submit
21 a statement of purpose and effect with each bill and appear personally
22 or through a representative before any committee considering legisla-
23 tion.
