6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the election of a candidate  
7 receiving a majority of all votes cast for an office  
8 in a primary election."

9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

10 \* Section 1. AS 15.25.100 is amended to read:

11 Sec. 15.25.100. PLACEMENT OF NOMINEES ON GENERAL ELECTION BALLOT.

12 The lieutenant governor shall place the name of the candidate receiving  
13 the highest number of votes for an office by a political party on the  
14 general election ballot, unless the candidate receives a majority of  
15 all votes cast for that office. If the candidate receives a majority  
16 of all votes cast for that office, he shall be declared elected.

17 \* Sec. 2. AS 15.25.190 is amended to read:

18 Sec. 15.25.190. PLACEMENT OF NAMES ON GENERAL ELECTION BALLOT.

19 The lieutenant governor shall place the names and the political group  
20 affiliation of persons who have been properly nominated by petition on  
21 the general election ballot, unless a candidate has already been  
22 declared elected to the office in the primary election under the  
23 provisions of sec. 100 of this chapter.
