6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the number of superior court  
7 judges; and providing for an effective date."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 \* Section 1. AS 22.10.120 is amended to read:

10 Sec. 22.10.120. NUMBER OF JUDGES. The superior court consists  
11 of 20 [16] judges, three of whom shall be judges in the first judicial  
12 district, one of whom shall be judge in the second judicial district,  
13 12 [NINE] of whom shall be judges in the third judicial district, and  
14 four [THREE] of whom shall be judges in the fourth judicial district.  
15 At the time of submitting the names of nominees to the governor to fill  
16 a vacancy on the superior court bench, the judicial council shall also  
17 designate the district in which the appointee is to reside and serve.

18 \* Sec. 2. This Act takes effect July 1, 1971.
