6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to district judges serving as United
7 States magistrates."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. AS 22.15.210(a) is amended to read:

10 (a) A district judge, while holding office, may not practice
11 law, except before a federal district court or federal agency and if
12 the practice does not interfere with the performance of his official
13 duties as judge. Except as provided in this section, a district judge
14 may not engage in the conduct of any other profession, vocation or
15 business for profit or compensation, hold office in a political party,
16 or hold any other office or position of profit under the United States,
17 the state or its political subdivisions. A [, EXCEPT THAT THE] district
18 judge may be appointed deputy clerk of the superior court and may hold
19 the office of United States magistrate [COMMISSIONER]. A district
20 judge who files for an elective public office forfeits his judicial
21 position.
