6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the taking of polar bear; and
7 providing for an effective date."
8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:
9 * Section 1. AS 16.05 is amended by adding a new section to read:
10 Sec. 16.05.409. TAKING OF POLAR BEAR WITH THE AID OR USE OF
11 AIRCRAFT UNLAWFUL. It is unlawful for a person to (1) take a polar
12 bear in the state with the aid or use of aircraft in any manner; or
13 (2) transport a polar bear or parts of a polar bear into the state
14 that has been taken with the aid or use of aircraft. For the
15 purpose of this section, taking with the aid or use of aircraft
16 includes the transportation of a polar bear or parts of it, hunters,
17 or hunting gear.
18 * Sec. 2. AS 16.05.430(a) is amended to read:
19 (a) A person who violates secs. 330, 409 or 420 of this chapter
20 is guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction is punishable by a fine
21 of not more than \$1,000, or by imprisonment for not more than six
22 months, or by both.
23 * Sec. 3. This Act takes effect January 1, 1973.
