BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

\* Section 1. AS 44.19 is amended by adding new sections to read:

ARTICLE 9D. GOVERNOR'S COMMISSION

12

ON THE ADMINISTRATION OF JUSTICE.

Sec. 44.19.746. ESTABLISHMENT OF THE COMMISSION. The Governor's  
Commission on the Administration of Justice is established in the  
Office of the Governor.

Sec. 44.19.748. MEMBERSHIP OF THE COMMISSION. The commission  
is composed of the attorney general, the commissioner of public safety,  
the commissioner of health and welfare, the chief justice of the  
supreme court, the public defender, one member from each house of  
the legislature and four other residents of the state chosen by the  
governor so as to give reasonable geographic and urban-rural balance,  
including representation from the major ethnic groups of the state,  
from units of local government and from other groups concerned with  
the administration of justice in the state. Members serve at the  
pleasure of the governor.

Sec. 44.19.750. COMPENSATION AND PER DIEM. Members of the  
commission receive no salary for their service on the commission but  
are entitled to per diem and travel expenses authorized by law for  
boards and commission.

1           Sec. 44.19.752. GRANTS AND OTHER AID. The commission may apply  
2 for, receive and utilize grants, gifts, and other funds and aids for  
3 the execution of its programs. Grants, gifts, and other funds may be  
4 received from the federal government and from other public and private  
5 sources.

6           Sec. 44.19.754. COMMISSION AS STATE PLANNING AGENCY. The  
7 commission shall act as the state planning agency under the Federal  
8 Omnibus Crime Control and Safe Streets Act of 1968, as amended.

9           Sec. 44.19.756. DUTIES OF THE STATE PLANNING AGENCY. As the  
10 state planning agency, the commission has the responsibility of  
11 coordinating and planning in Alaska, the federal, state, and local  
12 efforts under Title I of the Omnibus Crime Control and Safe Streets  
13 Act of 1968, as amended. The commission is authorized to investigate  
14 state and local needs and seek funding for

15           (1) development of more effective crime prevention programs  
16 and techniques;

17           (2) development of programs to aid the courts in the field  
18 of criminal adjudication;

19           (3) development of programs to rehabilitate offenders and  
20 prevent recidivism.

21           Sec. 44.19.758. STAFFING. (a) The attorney general may, with  
22 the approval of the governor, select a director for the execution of the  
23 program entrusted to the commission by Secs. 752 - 756 of this chapter.

24           (b) the director may employ personnel necessary to carry out  
25 functions assigned by this chapter. Notwithstanding any other pro-  
26 visions of law, personnel appointed under this section, with the  
27 exception of the director, are members of the classified service as  
28 set out in AS. 39.25.100.
