6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to persons eligible for gear licenses;
7 and providing for an effective date."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. AS 16.05.536(b)(2) is amended to read:

10 (2) either affidavits from two persons holding currently
11 valid gear licenses or who have held valid gear licenses during the
12 previous year in the area where the applicant desires to fish stating
13 that the applicant has fished the required time in that area, or for
14 each of three years statements prepared by the applicant, subsequent
15 to the effective date of this section, signed by employees of the
16 Department of Fish and Game evidencing that the applicant did report
17 in at a Department of Fish and Game office within the required area
18 during the required three years. Such other evidence as the department
19 may require may be given in lieu of the affidavit and statements
20 provided for in this subsection.

21 * Sec. 2. This Act takes effect on the day after its passage and approv-
22 al or on the day it becomes law without approval.
