* Section 1. AS 18 is amended by adding a new chapter to read:

CHAPTER 95. INTERMENT OF DECEASED PERSONS.

Sec. 18.95.010. INTERMENT OF DECEASED PERSONS. (a) Unless they

11

have been cremated the remains of a deceased person, including fetal

12

remains, shall be interred in a cemetery approved by the division of

13

vital statistics of the Department of Health and Welfare.

(b) Cemeteries where three or more bodies are interred on the

15

effective date of this Act shall be considered approved as required

16

by (a) of this section.
