6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to mediation and negotiation for  
7 certain educational personnel."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 \* Section 1. AS 14.20.560 is amended by adding a new subsection to read:

10 (f) Nothing in this section shall be construed to prevent  
11 certificated administrative personnel groups, including principals  
12 and assistant principals, from having the right to negotiate indepen-  
13 dently of the other certificated personnel if they choose to do so  
14 as the result of a secret ballot.

15 \* Sec. 2. AS 14.20.590 is amended by adding a new subsection to read:

16 (b) The grievance procedures shall contain:

17 (1) the definition of a "grievance"; that term includes an  
18 alleged misinterpretation or misapplication of a school board policy,  
19 rule, or regulation;

20 (2) a statement of purpose which includes the desire to  
21 secure equitable solutions to personnel problems at the lowest possible  
22 administrative level in furtherance of a sound public school personnel  
23 system;

24 (3) the administrative steps by which a grievance may be  
25 resolved and a stipulation as to the maximum time limit for resultant  
26 action at each level and a provision for ultimate appeal;

27 (4) a provision for arbitration as the terminal step of  
28 the grievance procedure that will provide for the resolution of the  
29 grievance by a neutral third party without the necessity for judicial

determination and the procedure by which the arbitrator is selected  
and compensated for his services.
