6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to boards of equalization within  
7 organized boroughs; and providing for an effective  
8 date."

9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

10 \* Section 1. AS 07.15.320 is amended by adding a new subsection to read:

11 (e) The borough assembly sits as a board of equalization for  
12 the purpose of hearing in the manner provided for first class cities  
13 any appeal from determinations of the borough assessor, or it may  
14 delegate this authority to a board appointed by it for that purpose.  
15 At least two members of the borough assembly shall be members of the  
16 board of equalization. The board of equalization is governed in its  
17 proceedings by such procedures consistent with general rules of adminis-  
18 trative law and the laws governing equalization proceedings in first  
19 class cities as may be adopted by ordinance, including but not limited  
20 to, quorum and voting requirements.

21 \* Sec. 2. This Act takes effect on the day after its passage and approval  
22 or on the day it becomes law without approval.
