6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the teachers retirement system."

7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

8 * Section 1. AS 14.25.110(a) is amended to read:

9 (a) A teacher who has either (1) completed 25 years of membership
10 service or (2) completed 15 years of creditable service, the last
11 five years of which have [HAS] been membership service in the state,
12 and has completed at least 10 years of membership service, and who
13 has attained the age of 55 years, may retire from service, and apply
14 in writing to the administrator for retirement salary. A retired
15 teacher who has been receiving a disability retirement salary shall
16 be eligible for a service retirement salary upon or after attaining
17 age 60.
