6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to snow vehicles."

7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

8 \* Section 1. AS 05.30 is amended by adding a new section to read:

9       Sec. 05.30.060. DEALER'S LICENSE. A person who is in the business  
10 of selling snow vehicles in the state shall register with the Department  
11 of Revenue as a dealer and secure a dealer's license. The fee for a  
12 dealer's license is \$25, which shall be paid into the general fund. A  
13 licensee under this section is authorized to demonstrate snow vehicles  
14 for the purpose of sale only. The vehicles under demonstration are  
15 not required to be individually registered, but the dealer's license  
16 number shall be displayed on each vehicle.

17 \* Sec. 2. AS 05.30.070 is amended to read:

18       Sec. 05.30.070. REGULATION [BY POLITICAL SUBDIVISION]. The  
19 Department of Public Safety shall promulgate regulations, not incon-  
20 sistent with this chapter, necessary to regulate the use and operation  
21 of snow vehicles. A city of any class, or an organized borough in the  
22 area outside cities, may, by ordinance no less strict than regulations  
23 promulgated under this chapter, regulate the use and operation of snow  
24 vehicles within the limits of their respective jurisdictions.

25 \* Sec. 3. AS 05.30 is amended by adding a new section to read:

26       Sec. 05.30.075. INFORMATION AND SAFETY EDUCATION TRAINING PROGRAM.  
27 The Department of Public Safety may establish a comprehensive snow  
28 vehicle information and safety education training program, including,  
29 but not limited to the preparation and dissemination of snowmobile

1 information and safety advice to the public, the training of snowmobile  
2 operators, and the issuance of snowmobile safety certificates to  
3 snowmobile operators who successfully complete the snowmobile safety  
4 education and training course.

5 \* Sec. 4. AS 05.30.080(4) is amended to read:

6 (4) an exhaust muffler in good working order that limits  
7 engine noise, under test procedures established by the department, to  
8 a level of not more than 83 PNdB (perceived noise by a sound level  
9 meter, in decibels) at 50 feet, except at the operator's option when  
10 participating in an event permitted under AS 05.35.
