IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA
SEVENTH LEGISLATURE - FIRST SESSION

A BILL

For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the initiative."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

* Section 1. AS 15.45.140 is repealed and re-enacted to read:

Sec. 15.45.140. FILING OF PETITION. The sponsors must file the initiative petition within 90 days from the time the sponsors received notice from the lieutenant governor that the petitions were ready for delivery to them, and the petition must be signed by qualified voters equal in number to 10 per cent of those who voted in the preceding general election and resident in at least two-thirds of the election districts of the state. If the petition is not filed within the 90-day period provided for in this section, the petition has no force or effect.
