6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to radiology."

7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

8 * Section 1. AS 18.60 is amended by adding new sections to read:

9 ARTICLE 7. USE OF RADIATION ON HUMANS.

10 Sec. 18.60.700. UNLAWFUL USE OF RADIATION ON HUMAN BEINGS. No
11 person may use radiotherapy, fluoroscopy, x-ray or other form of
12 ionizing radiation on a human being unless that person is licensed
13 under AS 08.64 as a physician or osteopath, or under AS 08.36 as a
14 dentist, or unless that person is under the direction, control and
15 supervision of a licensed physician, osteopath or dentist.

16 Sec. 18.60.710. REGULATIONS. The department shall promulgate
17 regulations necessary to carry out the purposes of secs. 700 - 740 of
18 this chapter. The department shall comply with the provisions of
19 the Administrative Procedure Act (AS 44.62).

20 Sec. 18.60.720. VIOLATIONS. (a) A person who violates sec. 700
21 of this chapter or who violates a regulation promulgated by the
22 department under sec. 710 of this chapter, is guilty of a misdemeanor
23 and upon conviction is punishable by a fine of not less than \$500 nor
24 more than \$5,000, or by imprisonment for not less than 30 days nor
25 more than one year, or by both, and shall forfeit all radiological
26 machines and equipment in which he has any interest to the state.

27 (b) Each day on which a person violates sec. 700 of this chapter
28 or a regulation promulgated by the department under sec. 710 of this
29 chapter shall be considered a separate offense.

1 Sec. 18.60.730. INJUNCTIVE RELIEF. The department or a person
2 may bring a civil action for injunctive relief to prevent the violation
3 of sec. 700 of this chapter or a regulation promulgated by the depart-
4 ment under sec. 710 of this chapter. The court may proceed in a
5 summary manner or otherwise and may restrain a person from committing
6 the violation.

7 Sec. 18.60.740. DEFINITIONS. In secs. 700 - 740 of this chapter
8 "department" means the Department of Health and Welfare.
