6 For an Act entitled: "An Act amending the requirements for holding  
7 legislative office; and providing for an effective  
8 date."

9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

10 \* Section 1. AS 24.05.030 is amended to read:

11 Sec. 24.050.030. QUALIFICATIONS OF MEMBERS. A member of the  
12 legislature shall be a qualified voter who has been a resident of the  
13 state for at least three years and of an area which, under the plan  
14 for redistricting and reapportionment in effect for the immediately  
15 preceding election, was a portion of the district from which he was  
16 elected, for at least six months. [THE DISTRICT FROM WHICH ELECTED  
17 FOR AT LEAST ONE YEAR IMMEDIATELY PRECEDING HIS FILING FOR OFFICE.  
18 A SENATOR SHALL BE AT LEAST 25 YEARS OF AGE AND A REPRESENTATIVE  
19 AT LEAST 21 YEARS OF AGE AT THE TIME HE TAKES HIS OATH OF OFFICE.]

20 \* Sec. 2. This Act takes effect on the effective date of an amendment  
21 to the Constitution of the State of Alaska making the same change.
