6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to retirement age of certain public
7 employees; and providing for an effective date."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. AS 39.35.380(a) is repealed and re-enacted to read:

10 (a) An employee is eligible for an early retirement pension if
11 his employment is terminated on or after his 50th birthday and after
12 he completes eight or more years of credited service.

13 * Sec. 2. AS 39.35.680(11) is amended to read:

14 (11) "normal retirement date" for a peace officer or a
15 fireman means the first day of the month following either his 55th
16 birthday and eight years of credited service or his 20th year of
17 credited service, whichever is earlier, and for any other employee it
18 means the first day of the month following either his 55th [60th]
19 birthday and eight years of credited service or his 30th year of
20 credited service, whichever is earlier;

21 * Sec. 3. This Act takes effect on July 1, 1972.
