6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the board of parole; and providing  
7 for an effective date."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 \* Section 1. AS 33.15 is amended by adding a new section to read:

10 Sec. 33.15.015. EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR. The board shall hire an  
11 executive director who has training and experience in the field of  
12 probation and parole and shall determine his salary. The executive  
13 director shall serve as the executive officer for the board in the  
14 accomplishment of its functions. He shall serve the board at the  
15 pleasure of the governor.

16 \* Sec. 2. AS 33.15.160 is amended to read:

17 Sec. 33.15.160. COMMISSIONER MAY DELEGATE ADMINISTRATIVE DUTIES  
18 TO EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR [BOARD CHAIRMAN]. The commissioner may delegate  
19 all or part of the administrative duties and responsibilities specified  
20 in sec. 150 of this chapter to the executive director [CHAIRMAN] of  
21 the board.

22 \* Sec. 3. This Act takes effect on the day after its passage and approval  
23 or on the day it becomes law without approval.
