6 For an Act entitled: "An Act exempting insurers from civil liability for
7 furnishing safety inspections or advisory services."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. AS 21.89 is amended by adding a new section to read:

10 Sec. 21.89.020. EXEMPTION FROM LIABILITY FOR FURNISHING INSPEC-
11 TIONS AND ADVISORY SERVICES. The furnishing of, or failure to furnish,
12 safety inspections or advisory services intended to reduce the likeli-
13 hood of injury, death or loss may not subject the insurer, its agent
14 or employee undertaking to perform these services as an incident to
15 insurance, to liability for damages, death or loss occurring as a
16 result of an act or omission in the course of these services. This
17 section does not apply if the negligence of the insurer, its agent
18 or employee created the condition which causes the injury, death or
19 loss, nor does it apply to services required to be performed under
20 the provisions of a written service contract.
