6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the assignment of teachers; and
7 providing for an effective date."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. AS 14.20 is amended by adding a new section to read:

10 Sec. 14.20.148. INTRADISTRICT TEACHER REASSIGNMENTS. When a
11 teacher is involuntarily transferred or reassigned to a position for
12 which he is qualified, within the district, his moving expenses shall
13 be paid unless the one-way driving distance is 20 miles or less from
14 the teacher's present place of residence, or unless otherwise mutually
15 agreed by the teacher and chief school administrator of the district.

16 * Sec. 2. This Act takes effect July 1, 1972.
