6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the transfer of attendance areas;
7 and providing for an effective date."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. AS 14.20 is amended by adding a new section to read:

10 Sec. 14.20.147. ATTENDANCE AREA TRANSFER, ABSORPTION. When an
11 attendance area is transferred from a currently operating district to,
12 or absorbed into, a new or existing school district, the teachers for
13 the attendance area also shall be transferred unless otherwise mutually
14 agreed by the teacher or teachers and the chief school administrator
15 of the new district. Accumulated or earned benefits, including but
16 not limited to, seniority, salary level, tenure, leave, and retire-
17 ment, accompany the teacher who is transferred.

18 * Sec. 2. This Act takes effect July 1, 1972.
