For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to discrimination in insurance rates."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

* Section 1. AS 21.36.120 is amended by adding new subsections to read:

(e) In boroughs or cities of any class no insurer may make or permit unfair discrimination between risks of essentially the same degree of hazard in the issuance of burglary and theft or robbery insurance policies or casualty insurance policies which insure against liability to persons arising out of the use or control of real or personal property other than motor vehicles.

(f) Property insured or persons insured against liability arising out of use or control of real or personal property other than motor vehicles, if comparable in other respects in exposures to the peril insured against, may not be considered to be of different hazard solely because of the geographic location of the property or the place of residence or business of the person to be insured.
