6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the medical profession."

7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

8 \* Section 1. AS 08.64.370(5) is amended to read:

9 (5) a person while serving as a student [TRAINEE], intern,  
10 resident physician, or [POST-DOCTORATE] fellow at a hospital, clinic,  
11 or medical facility [OFFICE] in the state; however, service at a medical  
12 facility, other than a hospital or clinic, is subject to the approval  
13 of the board and includes, but is not limited to, an in-service training  
14 program or attendance at, or the giving of, a course of instruction,  
15 lecture or series of lectures in the medical sciences or healing arts.

16 \* Sec. 2. AS 08.64.370 is amended by adding a new paragraph to read:

17 (6) a physician in the regular medical service of the United  
18 States Public Health Service or the armed services of the United States  
19 volunteering his services without pay, donation or other remuneration  
20 to a hospital, clinic, medical office, or other medical facility in  
21 the state.
